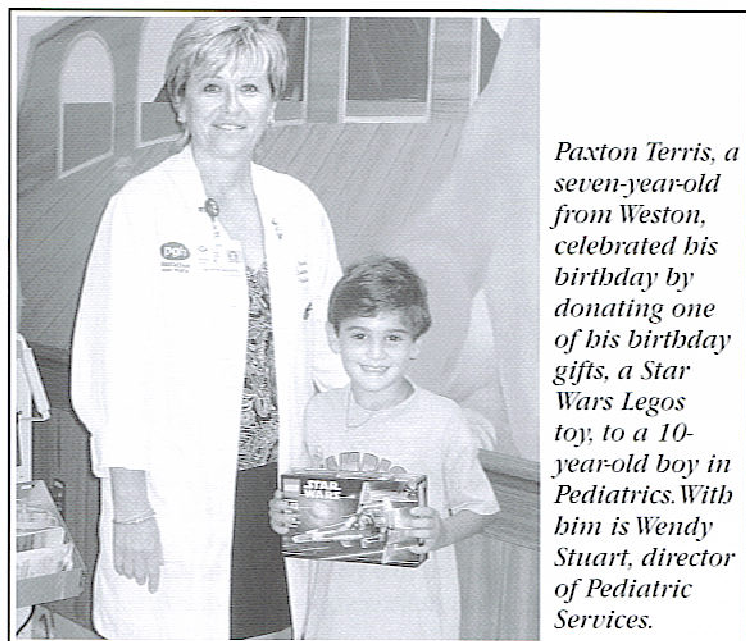
We get letters ...
